The Carnival of the Animals is a suite of fourteen pieces of music written by the French composer Camille Saint-Saëns in the nineteenth century. The music has been popular with children and adults alike since its first publication, and has famously been used many times in adverts, trailers for films and even in ballet. Originally commissioned by Junction, Goole, Finger and Thumb Theatre's brand new performance of the work is a riot of hand shadow animals dancing, cavorting and bumping into one another accompanied by live music. Here the audience will encounter lions (but not tigers and bears!), fish, kangaroos, elephants, donkeys, a whole flock of birds and even a wild pianist!

Suitable for a family audience 4+ the performance lasts 50 minutes.

A workshop around creating the animals seen in the show is available.
